- Crimes Compensation (Victims of Crime)
- Motor Vehicle Accidents – property damage
- Neighbourhood Disputes
- Children’s Court (*only if a conflict with Victoria Legal Aid*)
- Social Security (*VLA outreach service to Box Hill and Boronia offices*)
- Discrimination (*not work related*)
